Recent work has included:

- Drafted proceedings on behalf of homeowners in a building claim valued at over £100,000 where there was very little documentation as to the agreement. The defendant was not a professional contractor and there were many variations. The homeowners alleged that the defendant fraudulently misrepresented that additional works were required by building control.
- Advised and drafted a defence, reply and additional claim in proceedings for recovery of sums due under oral agreements between contractors. The defence was based on agency, the agreements having been concluded on his brother's behalf. Advised on and negotiated compromise of proceedings.
