#### Some notable recent cases

*HMRC v Carron-Brown* -

defence junior in a complex 'white collar' VAT fraud.

*R v Cleall* [2009] EWCA Crim 66 -

successful appeal against sentence that considered the approach to be adopted when sentencing mothers of young children to custodial terms.

*R v Eunice Spry* -

defence junior in infamous case of a step-mother accused of extreme cruelty to her children over a period of 14 years.

*R v Rasiak* -

defending a well known footballer in driving matters.

*R v X* -

successful defence of a 13 year old accused of sexual assault by penetration.

*West Dorset DC v AK -*

long running application for a civil ASBO.
